

Year 4 – Term 4

English

Our class novel this term is Blodin the Beast - Michael Morpurgo. Inspired by this story and using drama techniques to explore the characters and story in more depth, we shall be inspired to write narrative which includes dialogue, poetry and play scripts.

Weekly spelling to be practised at home will continue to be taken from the National Curriculum spelling list Year 3/4 and words that contain the same spelling patterns.

The spellings will appear on the school's weekly newsletter.

During our dedicated gramma sessions we shall be exploring: correct use of inverted commas (speech marks), use commas to separate clauses effectively, adverbial sentence openers; identifying and changing tense and double negatives.

In guided reading we shall continue to read and discuss selected texts and extracts that will help develop comprehension skills.

Maths

This term we will continue to focus on problem solving while further deepening our understanding of time, decimals and money.

Weekly times table and associated division facts to be practised at home will appear on the school's weekly newsletter.

This term we will be learning about Creation Stories and Easter.
