Castles

This term we will be reading *The Queen's Knickers*, *the Queens Orang-Utan* and other Royal texts. We will be using these texts to write our own poems, stories and posters.

In History, we will be exploring the history of castles. We will look at how they were built, who built them and how they protected the Royal families.

In Art, we will be looking at the artist L.S Lowry. We will look at how to mix paint from Lowry colours. We will begin to draw simple buildings and seascapes with matchstick figures. Finally, we will attempt to recreate our own L.S Lowry painting.

Our trip this term is to visit Leeds castle where we will get to see the beautiful grounds, the amazing castle and learn all about its previous owners such as Edward I and Henry VIII.

In Maths, we will continue to look at numbers bonds to 20. We will also begin to look at multiplication and division.

In RE, we will be looking at the Easter story.
